RETURN TO IN-PERSON LEARNING FIVE DAYS PER WEEK...

As we all know, the governor's recent executive order requires all NH schools to offer in-person learning five days per week by April 19th. Spark has been in-person four days per week since March 1st with Wednesdays for remote programs. As of the 19th, we will be in-person Monday through Friday. However, our Wednesday schedules will continue to feature programs that differ from our normal class days.

We will continue with health classes, virtual tours of NH industries,



art classes and more. As of the 19th. however, we will simply conduct those programs

here on the MCC campus. We are in discussions with the college to allow our use of the Multipurpose Room (MPR) for at least part of our Wednesday schedule. Until mid-May, the college's nursing program uses this space for instruction. Therefore, the seating you see in this photo cannot be moved until Mid-May when the Nursing Program's Spring Semester ends.

We hope to be allowed to use the MPR more freely at the conclusion of the college's Spring Semester. Even with seating in place, the MPR will provide us with excellent space for group presentations, discussions, and activities.

We will also take advantage of nice spring weather for appropriate outdoor

activities such as today's physics class where sensors tracked various aspects of this rocket's flight.

Remote learning remains possible at the current time

for families requesting that option. However, the benefit of having your children with us in the classrooms appears to have been of great benefit to our students. I would encourage all of you to continue sending your kids to school if medical concerns or possible Covid exposure are not an issue for your families.

Spark will be closed from April 26th to the 30th. As your family is perhaps making plans to enjoy time together, we ask that everyone continue to be vigilant with respect to Covid safety.
