I was able to meet on Thursday with MCC President, Dr. Brian Bicknell, to discuss the college's status regarding on-campus student attendance. For now, it seems most prudent for Spark to remain fully remote. Dr. Bicknell and I will meet mid-January to assess then the prospects of our returning to our hybrid model. We all hope hybrid learning can be a relatively brief transition to fully in-person classes. Let's all keep our fingers crossed!

In the meantime, please keep me posted should your family experience any COVID contact or possible exposure. This information will allow me to keep the NH Dept. of Health & Human Services informed of Spark's status with respect to possible exposure and will provide me with data to bring to my next meeting with Dr. Bicknell.
